- **Open Science**

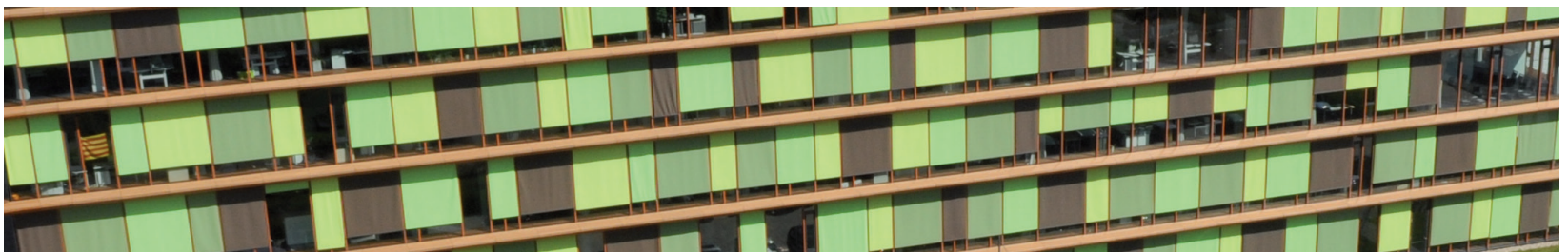
Open Science (or Science 2.0) is a philosophy in which data, research and results are freely accessible to anyone without copyright, patents or other control mechanisms. In an interactive presentation we are introducing the theory behind Open Science and we will investigate the extent to which Young PSG employees are already using Open Science and where chances are to be found. After the presentation we will have a discussion on the following statement: The peer review system is still tenable when *Open Science* becomes the standard.
